JACO A is pleased to offer an alternative to Level I Outpatient Counseling in a one day - three hour lecture - format. The JACO A Early Intervention Classes are **ONLY** for individuals who are at least 18 years old and in the Beginning Stage of chemical dependency. Each participant will receive increased insight into (1) Chemical Dependency - a disease, (2) Denial - the main symptom of chemical dependency, and (3) The Three Stages of Chemical Dependency with emphasis on the Beginning Stage. As of this time, JACO A offers:

- A three hour Monday morning class (9 a.m. - Noon)

All persons registering for the Early Intervention Class must be screened in-person at JACO A or by phone with JACO A staff **at least three days** before the scheduled class. Registration fees must be paid **before the start time of the scheduled/registered class, but fees don't have to be paid until the client shows up for the class.**
